Granite Worktops: Cleaning, Maintenance, etc.

- Granite worktops need to be sealed before and/or upon installation, then re-sealed every six months or so. Check with your supplier for recommended sealer.
- Cleaning of granite worktops. Granite (especially those types of granite that have a higher water absorption rate, like Kashmir White or Kashmir Gold, for example) can be stained by wine, black tea, coffee, fruit (especially lemon) juices, other chemical or organic substances. The surface of the worktop should be cleaned immediately with a soft cloth and water. If damage is more serious then special natural stone care products (check with your supplier) should be used.
- Hot pots and pans should not be placed directly on a granite worktop.
- Avoid scratching the surface of granite worktops.
- In case of scratching, light scratches on granite worktops can usually be removed with granite restoration powder or paste. Contact your supplier for advice.
- The most popular granite for granite worktops is Absolute Black or other types of black granite or basalt.
- Typical lead time on most granite worktops (from order till installation) is one to two weeks for most areas of London and Surrey.
